LETTER DATED 5 MAY 1983 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF NICARAGUA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour, on express instructions from my Government, to request you to convene a meeting of the Security Council as a matter of urgency for the purpose of reviewing the situation and considering possible measures to be taken, in view of the launching of a new stage of the invasion of my country by counter-revolutionary Somozist forces operating out of Honduras and financed, trained and supported by the present United States Administration, and in view of the recent threats made against the Nicaraguan Revolution by the very people who are to blame for the present situation.

It is my Government's hope that at the meeting the Council will be able to devise specific ways of helping to resolve a situation which, should it continue and deteriorate, would endanger international peace and security.
