## NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

- 1. At the 113th plenary meeting of its fortieth session, on 12 December 1985, the General Assembly adopted resolution 40/93, entitled "Israeli nuclear armament". 1/
- 2. In paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 of that resolution, the General Assembly
  - \*3. Requests once more the Security Council to take urgent and effective measures to ensure that Israel complies with Security Council resolution 487 (1981) and places all its nuclear facilities under International Atomic Energy Agency safeguards)
  - "4. Reiterates its request to the Security Council to investigate
    Israel's nuclear activities and the collaboration of other States, parties and institutions in these activities)
  - "5. <u>Calls upon</u> all States and organizations that have not yet done so to discontinue co-operating with and giving assistance to Israel in the nuclear field".
