NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

- 1. At the 117th plenary meeting of its fortieth session, on 16 December 1985, the General Assembly adopted resolution 40/158, entitled "Review of the implementation of the Declaration on the Strengthening of International Security". 1/
- 2. In paragraphs 10 and 11 of that resolution, the General Assembly
 - "10. <u>Emphasizes</u> that the Security Council should consider holding periodic meetings in specific cases to consider and review outstanding problems and crises, thus enabling the Council to play a more active role in preventing conflicts;
 - "11. Reiterates the need for the Security Council, in particular its permanent members, to ensure the effective implementation of its decisions in compliance with the relevant provisions of the Charter".
