LETTER DATED 21 AUGUST 1987 FROM THE ACTING PRESIDENT AND  
MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAURU  
**ADDRESSED** TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL, CONCERNING NAURU'S  
APPLICATION TO BECOME A PARTY TO THE STATUTE OF THE  
INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE

In virtue of Article 93, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations, which provides **that** a State which is **not** a member of the United Nations **may become** a party to the Statute of the International Court of Justice **on conditions to be** determined in each case by the General **Assembly** upon the recommendation **of** the Security Council. the Republic of **Nauru hereby informs** Your Excellency of its desire to become a party to the Statute of the Court, requests you to inform the Security Council and the General Assembly of this application, and waits to be informed of the conditions required to **become a party to the Statute.**
