REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 13
OF SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 883 (1993)

- 1. On 11 November 1993, the Security Council, acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, adopted resolution 883 (1993), following its consideration of the item entitled "Letters dated 20 and 23 December 1991 from France, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America (S/23306, S/23307, S/23308, S/23309 and S/23317)", relating to the question of compliance by the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya with its obligations under Council resolutions 731 (1992) and 748 (1992).
- 2. In paragraph 12 of resolution 883 (1993) the Security Council called upon all States, including States not Members of the United Nations, and all international organizations, to act strictly in accordance with the provisions of that resolution.
- 3. Under paragraph 13 of the same resolution, the Council requested all States to report to the Secretary-General by 15 January 1994 on the measures they had instituted for meeting their obligations under resolution 883 (1993).
- 4. Immediately following the adoption of resolution 883 (1993), the Secretary-General transmitted the text of the resolution by telegram to the Ministers for Foreign Affairs of all States.
- 5. As of 24 January 1994, 24 replies had been received pursuant to paragraph 13 of resolution 883 (1993). Each of the replies has been issued as a document of the Security Council in the chronological order of the communications, as indicated below:
