REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL PURSUANT TO SECURITY COUNCIL
RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)

Addendum

1. Since the issuance of my report to the Council of 10 July 1996 (S/1996/541) and the addenda of 17 and 23 July 1996 (S/1996/541/Add.1 and Add.2), a further seven replies have been received from six States (five Member States and one non-Member State), bringing to 60 the total of replies received as at 15 August 1996 (two of them from the same non-Member State). All the replies have been published as documents of the Security Council (see annex).

INFORMATION RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF PARAGRAPH 3 OF
RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)

2. The seven replies received provided information regarding paragraph 3 of resolution 1054 (1996). Two States reported that they had taken action in compliance with paragraph 3 (a) and (b) of the resolution. Three States reported that they had taken appropriate measures in compliance with paragraph 3 (b), two of which further indicated that, as they did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in their country, the provisions of paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution did not apply; the other State further added that since the Sudan had no diplomatic representation in it, its Government did not deem it necessary to take any action in implementation of paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution. One State reported that it did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in it and that the competent authorities had adopted appropriate measures to comply with the provisions of paragraph 3 of the resolution.
