LETTER DATED 1 AUGUST 1997 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I would like to refer to my announcement to the Security Council on 8 July 1997 that I intended to appoint an investigative team in order to investigate alleged grave violations of human rights and international humanitarian law in the Democratic Republic of the Congo committed since 1 March 1993, and to the briefing the Council received on the subject on 30 July.

I am now pleased to inform you, and through you the members of the Council, that I have decided to appoint Mr. Atsu-Koffi Amega (Togo) and Mr. Andrew R. Chigovera (Zimbabwe) to be respectively the Chairman and a member of the investigative team. I intend to appoint a third member within the next few days.
