REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE UNITED NATIONS
PREVENTIVE DEPLOYMENT FORCE PURSUANT TO SECURITY
COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1110 (1997)

Addendum

1. In paragraph 31 of my report to the Security Council dated 20 November 1997 (S/1997/911), I indicated that an addendum to the report would be issued on the financial aspects of extending the mandate of the United Nations Preventive Deployment Force (UNPREDEP) for an additional period of six months until 31 May 1998 in the strength and configuration described in paragraph 3 of that report.
2. The General Assembly, in its resolution 51/154 B of 13 June 1997, appropriated an amount of \$46,506,700 for UNPREDEP for the period from 1 July 1997 to 30 June 1998. That authorization is subject to the decision of the Security Council to extend the mandate of the Force.
3. Should the Security Council decide to extend the mandate of the Force for a further six-month period as I have recommended, the monthly cost of maintaining the Force at its reduced strength until 31 May 1998 would be within the appropriation contained in resolution 51/154 B (equivalent to \$3.6 million per month).
4. As at 21 November 1997, unpaid assessed contributions to the UNPREDEP special account amounted to \$7.9 million. The total outstanding assessed contributions for all peacekeeping operations at that date amounted to \$1.7 billion.
