LETTER DATED 30 JUNE 1998 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Security Council takes note of the letter dated 23 June 1998 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1998/590), which refers to Security Council resolution 1012 (1995) of 28 August 1995, by which the Council requested the Secretary-General to establish an international commission of inquiry into the assassination of the President of Burundi on 21 October 1993, as well as to establish a trust fund to receive voluntary contributions, as a supplement to help finance the work of the commission. The letter informs the Council that, according to the Financial Rules and Regulations of the United Nations, the legislative authority establishing a trust fund should formally decide to close it.

The Security Council hereby authorizes the closing of the trust fund established pursuant to resolution 1012 (1995).
