Letter dated 10 June 1999 from the Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization addressed to the Secretary-General

Yesterday NATO military authorities agreed with the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) on the procedures and modalities for the withdrawal from Kosovo of FRY security forces.

FRY security forces have begun to withdraw from Kosovo in accordance with these agreed procedures and modalities. NATO is monitoring the FRY's compliance closely. Against this background, NATO air operations against the FRY have been suspended.

I look forward to keeping in close touch with you on this matter and the evolution of the overall situation.
