Letter dated 25 October 2000 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

Terms of reference of the Security Council mission to East Timor and Indonesia, 9-18 November 2000

At the invitation of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Transitional Administrator for East Timor, Mr. Sergio Vieira de Mello, the members of the Security Council have decided to send a mission to East Timor to review the progress in the implementation of Security Council resolution 1272 (1999).

Pursuant to the official communiqué issued by the Security Council following its meeting held in private on 12 October 2000 (S/PV.4206), on which occasion His Excellency Mr. Alwi Shihab, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Indonesia, extended an invitation to the Security Council, the mission will visit Indonesia to review the implementation of Security Council resolution 1319 (2000).
