

# Note by the President of the Security Council

## Corrigendum

#### 1. Page 1 should read

The attached final report of the Monitoring Mechanism on Sanctions Against UNITA established by resolution 1295 (2000) was presented to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola. The report is being circulated for the information of the Members of the United Nations. Consideration of the report in the 864 (1993) Sanctions Committee is beginning, after which the Committee will officially present the report to the Security Council.

5. The Monitoring Mechanism on Sanctions Against UNITA has had two points of departure for its work: the report of the Panel of Experts and the current situation on the ground in Angola. Efforts have been made to follow up on leads provided but not investigated by the Panel due to the shortage of time. One objective has been to try to shed even more light on the interaction between UNITA and the shady arms dealers and transporters who have been instrumental in the rearmament of that organization for reasons of profit and

greed rather than ideology. Another objective has been to look at the sanctions, their implementation and importance in the context of the current situation.
