Letter dated 5 October 2000 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of Security Council resolution 689 (1991), and in the light of your report of 27 September 2000 (S/2000/914), the members of the Council have reviewed the question of the termination or continuation of United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission (UNIKOM) and its modalities of operation.

I have the honour to inform you that the members of the Security Council concur with your recommendation that UNIKOM be maintained. In accordance with Council resolution 689 (1991), they have decided to review the question once again by 6 April 2001.
