Letter dated 31 May 2001 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to my mission of good offices in Cyprus.

Further to my letter of 14 December 2000 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2000/1188), I should like to draw your attention to the fact that efforts related to my mission of good offices in Cyprus will continue at least throughout the current year.

In furtherance of the mission entrusted to me, which includes consultations in the region as well as with various capitals as required, my Special Adviser on Cyprus, Alvaro de Soto, will continue to be assisted by a small team.

I should be grateful if you would bring this letter to the attention of the members of the Security Council and alert them to the importance of continuing to support my efforts in discharging my mission in Cyprus.
