Letter dated 14 November 2003 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1284 (1999), which requires me to consult the Security Council and the Executive Chairman of the United Nations Monitoring, Verification and Inspection Commission (UNMOVIC) on the appointment of suitably qualified experts as UNMOVIC Commissioners.

Li Junhua has resigned from the College of Commissioners. After consultations with the acting Executive Chairman of UNMOVIC, I would like to propose the appointment of Chen Weixiong (China) as a Commissioner of UNMOVIC.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the Security Council.
