## Report of the Secretary-General on Côte d'Ivoire

## Addendum

1. As indicated in paragraph 87 of my main report (S/2003/374), I wish to inform the Security Council that the financial implications for the establishment of the United Nations Mission in Côte d'Ivoire (MINUCI) is currently projected at some US\$ 26.9 million for a 12-month period.

2. The projections provide for the deployment of 255 military and civilian personnel, consisting of 76 military liaison officers, 85 international and 89 national staff and 5 United Nations Volunteers.

3. An indicative breakdown of the projection for the establishment of MINUCI by main categories of expenditure is provided, for information purposes, in the annex to the present addendum.

4. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly, should the Security Council decide to establish MINUCI, that the related costs should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations.
