**Twenty-fifth report of the Secretary-General on the
United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone****Addendum**

1. My detailed budget for the United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL) for the period from 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006 (A/59/758), totalling \$107.2 million, comprising an amount of \$89.3 million for the maintenance of the Mission for the period from 1 July to 31 December 2005 and an amount of \$17.9 million for the liquidation of the Mission for the period from 1 January to 30 June 2006, is currently before the General Assembly for its consideration and approval.
2. Should the Security Council approve the recommendation set out in paragraph 78 of my main report (S/2005/273) as to the extension of the mandate of UNAMSIL until the end of 2005, the cost for the maintenance and liquidation of the Mission during that period will be limited to resources approved by the General Assembly.
3. As at 30 April 2005, unpaid assessed contributions to the special account for UNAMSIL amounted to \$94.5 million. The total outstanding assessed contributions for all peacekeeping operations at that date amounted to \$2.2 billion.
