Letter dated 20 June 2006 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the agreement between the Republic of Cameroon and the Federal Republic of Nigeria concerning the modalities of withdrawal and transfer of authority in the Bakassi Peninsula.

The agreement was signed at Greentree, New York, on 12 June 2006 by Paul Biya, President of the Republic of Cameroon, and Olusegun Obasanjo, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, and was witnessed by representatives of the Federal Republic of Germany, the United States of America, the French Republic and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

I should be grateful if you would bring the present matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
