**Letter dated 29 January 2007 from the Secretary-General  
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1731 (2006) concerning Liberia, adopted on 20 December 2006, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts appointed pursuant to resolution 1689 (2006) for a further period, until 20 June 2007. In paragraph 5 of resolution 1731 (2006) the Council also requested me to reappoint the members of the Panel of Experts and to make the necessary financial and security arrangements to support the work of the Panel.
