**Letter dated 3 September 2007 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Mission in the Sudan (UNMIS) established by Security Council resolution 1590 (2005) and extended by resolution 1755 (2007).

Following the usual consultations, I would like to inform you that it is my intention to appoint Ashraf Jehangir Qazi (Pakistan) as my Special Representative for the Sudan. Mr. Qazi is currently serving as my Special Representative for Iraq. He will replace Jan Pronk, who served as Special Representative for the Sudan from August 2004 to December 2006. Since Mr. Pronk's departure, Taye-Brook Zerihoun has served as Acting Special Representative. I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to both Mr. Pronk and Mr. Zerihoun for their dedicated service with UNMIS.

I would be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
