### Letter dated 28 November 2007 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1782 (2007) concerning Côte d'Ivoire. By paragraph 8 of the resolution, the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Group of Experts until 31 October 2008 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures.
