**Fourth special report of the Secretary-General on the
United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic
Republic of the Congo****Addendum**

1. Further to my fourth report on the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUC) (S/2008/728), I wish to inform the Security Council that the financial implications for a temporary increase of MONUC's authorized military strength by up to 2,785 military personnel, and the strength of its formed police unit by up to 300 personnel, as approved by the Security Council in its resolution 1843 (2008) of 20 November 2008, are currently estimated, for a 12-month period, at some \$279 million.
2. The preliminary projections of \$279 million provide for the deployment of 2,785 military contingent personnel, comprising two infantry battalions, two special forces companies, additional air assets of 18 rotary-wing and two fixed-wing aircraft, including related personnel, information analysis capability, one engineer company, and military training instructors and advisers, as well as two formed police units (total of 300 personnel).
3. The projections also provide for additional civilian personnel, comprising 12 international staff, 28 national staff and 19 United Nations Volunteers, as well as for the acquisition of major items of equipment, including prefabricated facilities, vehicles, communications and information technology equipment.
4. An indicative breakdown of the projections for a temporary increase of MONUC's authorized strength is provided, for information purposes only, in the annex to the present addendum.
5. It would be my intention to seek related additional resources for the current financial period ending 30 June 2009 from the General Assembly at the main part of its sixty-third session and to include these requirements in my proposed budget for the 2009/10 period.
