Pursuant to paragraph 18 of Security Council resolution [2100 \(2103\)](#), please find below the report of France on actions taken since 1 April 2014 by French forces in support of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA). This is the fourth such report since the establishment of MINUSMA.

Following the incidents that occurred in Kidal on 16 and 17 May, Operation Serval transferred one wounded Senegalese (category A) from the Gao airport to the MINUSMA hospital. He had previously been evacuated from Kidal to Gao in a MINUSMA M18 helicopter.
