**Letter dated 7 October 2016 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2265 \(2016\)](#) of 10 February 2016, by which the Council decided to extend until 12 March 2017 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on the Sudan established pursuant to resolution [1591 \(2005\)](#) and requested that I take the necessary administrative measures in that regard.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1591 \(2005\)](#) concerning the Sudan, I have appointed the following experts:

- Mr. Thomas Bifwoli Wanjala, transport and customs (Kenya);
- Mr. Vincent Darracq, regional (France);
- Ms. Daniela Kravetz Miranda, international humanitarian law (Chile);
- Mr. Warren Melia, arms (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland);
- Mr. Abhai Kumar Srivastav, finance (India)

I have also designated Mr. Wanjala to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
