**Information bulletin from the Russian Federation Ministry of
Defence regarding the status of implementation of the
Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas (28 July 2018)**

Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported three incidents of gunfire: two in Ladhikiyah Governorate and one in Hama Governorate.

The Turkish representative office has reported four incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: two in Hama, one in Aleppo and one in Idlib.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out one humanitarian operation. In Tabiyah, Dayr al-Zawr Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were distributed.

In total, 1,874 humanitarian operations have been carried out.

The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,816.26 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 88 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 86,450 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is 2,518.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out two humanitarian operations.

- In Tafas, Dar'a Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.6 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.
- In Kafr Nan, Homs Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.

In total, 1,876 humanitarian operations have been carried out.

The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,855.66 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 71 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 86,635 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is 2,518.
