(1 August 2018)**

**Observance of the ceasefire regime**

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported eight incidents of gunfire: three in Aleppo Governorate and one in Ladhqiyyah Governorate.

The Turkish representative office has reported four incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: two in Hama, one in Idlib and one in Ladhqiyyah.

**Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic**

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out two humanitarian operations:

- In Muntar, Aleppo Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were delivered to people in need.
- In Ghantu, Homs Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were delivered to people in need.

In total, 1,879 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,861.36 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 100 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 86,851 residents.

**Reconciliation of opposing sides**

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is 2,518.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

**Observance of the ceasefire regime**

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported six incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: three in Ladhikiyah, two in Aleppo and one in Hama.

The Turkish representative office has not reported any incidents of gunfire.

**Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic**

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has not carried out any humanitarian operations over the past 24 hours.

In total, 1,879 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,861.36 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 14 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 86,865 residents.

**Reconciliation of opposing sides**

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is 2,518.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

## **Information bulletin from the Russian Federation Ministry of Defence regarding the status of implementation of the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas (3 August 2018)**

### **Observance of the ceasefire regime**

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported 11 incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: 6 in Aleppo, 4 in Ladhqiyyah and 1 in Hama.

The Turkish representative office has reported two incidents of gunfire in Hama Governorate.

### **Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic**

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out four humanitarian operations:

- In Kafr Akkar, Aleppo Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.
- In Yadudah, Darʿa Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.6 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.
- In Mazlum, Dayr al-Zawr Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.
- In Dar al-Kabirah, Homs Governorate, 650 food parcels with a total weight of 2.8 tons were distributed as humanitarian aid.

In total, 1,883 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,872.36 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 298 residents.

### **Reconciliation of opposing sides**

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is 2,518.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.
