Letter dated 30 May 2019 from the Permanent Representative of Turkey to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I am writing to you with reference to the Syrian regime representative's letters and recent remarks delivered at the Security Council, a list of which is attached (see annex).

Turkey unequivocally refutes the false allegations contained in those letters and remarks. The regime cannot divert the attention of the international community from the atrocities that it has committed, which amount to war crimes and crimes against humanity, through such baseless allegations.

The Syrian regime and its representatives lost their legitimacy long ago. The regime remains the very root cause of all the problems emanating from the Syrian conflict and will be held accountable for its crimes.

I would be grateful if the present letter and its annex could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
