The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported one incident of gunfire in Hama Governorate.

The Turkish representative office has reported 18 incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: 16 in Hama, 1 in Aleppo and 1 in Idlib.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides and Refugee Migration Monitoring has not carried out any humanitarian operations over the past 24 hours.

In total, 2,156 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 3,466.881 tons.

- In Marrat, Dayr al-Zawr Governorate, 500 food parcels with a total weight of 2.420 tons were distributed.
