Letter dated 29 July 2019 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 2478 (2019), by which the Council decided to extend, until 1 August 2020, the mandate of the Group of Experts on the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

- Ms. Sophia Pickles, natural resources/finance expert (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)
- Mr. David Zounmenou, armed groups (Benin)

I have designated Mr. Zounmenou to serve as Coordinator of the Group.
