Letter dated 21 January 2019 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to your letter dated 21 December 2018 in which you concurred with my proposal to appoint Mr. Mahandrisoa Edmond Randrianirina (Madagascar) as a judge of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals to replace Judge Mparany Mamy Richard Rajohnson (Madagascar), who passed away on 2 October 2018.

I have received a corresponding letter from the President of the General Assembly (see annex). Accordingly, I am proceeding to appoint Mr. Randrianirina as a judge of the Mechanism with immediate effect.

In accordance with article 10, paragraph 2, of the Statute of the Mechanism, the appointment of Mr. Randrianirina is effective for the remainder of the term of office that the late Judge Rajohnson would have served, that is, until 30 June 2020.

I should be grateful if you would bring the present letter and its annex to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
