Letter dated 6 April 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2564 (2021), adopted on 25 February 2021, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Yemen until 28 March 2022.

I have designated Ms. Gunaratne to serve as Coordinator of the Panel. One additional expert will be appointed shortly.
