Letter dated 2 August 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2216 \(2015\)](#), by which the Council requested me to intensify my good offices role in order to enable a resumption of a peaceful, inclusive, orderly and Yemeni-led political transition process that would meet the legitimate demands and aspirations of the Yemeni people, as well as other Council resolutions on Yemen, including resolutions [2014 \(2011\)](#), [2051 \(2012\)](#), [2451 \(2018\)](#) and [2452 \(2019\)](#).

I wish to inform you of my intention to appoint Mr. Hans Grundberg (Sweden) as my new Special Envoy for Yemen, at the level of Under-Secretary-General. He will succeed Mr. Martin Griffiths (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), who has served as my Special Envoy since March 2018. I should like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to Mr. Griffiths for his tireless efforts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
