**Letter dated 12 August 2022 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2644 \(2022\)](#), adopted on 13 July 2022, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya until 15 November 2023.

I have designated Mr. Marjane to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.
