

Letter dated 12 August 2022 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2644 (2022), adopted on 13 July 2022, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya until 15 November 2023.

I have designated Mr. Marjane to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.
