

- 1. Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in accordance with the note by the President dated 30 August 2017 (S/2017/507), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

- 3. The present addendum lists the items on which the Security Council took action during the week ending 27 January 2024. The dates given for each item indicate when the item was first taken up by the Council at a formal meeting, and the most recent formal meeting of the Council held on that item.
