NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

At its 3107th meeting, on 17 August 1992, following the adoption of resolution 772 (1992), in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled, "The question of South Africa", the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:
