THE DATE OH ETACTION TO TITE A VACANCY IN THE INTHRNATIONAL COURI OF JUSITCE

## Note by the Sec "etary Genergl

The Vice-Fresident of the Internetionel Court of Justice informed the Secretery-General, by a commication detea 30 rovember 1953; of the death of Judge Sir Benegal Rau. It will be recalled that Judge Rau was elected on 6 December 1.951 for a term to expire on 5 February 1961. Thus a vacancy in the Court hes occurred and must be filled in accordance with the terms of the Statute of the International Court of Justice. Article 14 of the Statute provides:
"Vacancies shall be filled by the same method as that laid down for the first election, subject to the folloving provision: the SecretaryGeneral shall, within one month of the occurrence of the vacancy, proceed to issue the invitations provided for in Article 5, and the date of the election shall be fized by the Security Council."
Paragraph $I$ of Article 5 of the statute provides:
"At least three months before the dete of the election, the SecretaryGeneral of the United detions shall address a written request to the members of the Permanent Court of Arbitration belonging to the States which are parties to the present statute, and to members of the national groups eppointed under Article 4, paragrac:. 2, inviting them to undertake, within a given tine, by national groups, the nomination of persons in a position to accopt the duties of a member of the Court."
The invitations were issued on 14 Devomber 1953 and the Secretary-General has already received several nominations for the vecancy. Since, under Articie 14 of the statute, the Security Council has to fix the date of the election, it is suggested that the Council should meet as soon as possible in order to decide the date of the election.

It may be noted that owing to the expiration of the terms of office of five members of the Court, an election will be held to fill the five vacancies during the ninth session of the General Assembly. The precise date of this election will not be set until the opening of the General Assembly. In accordance with the practice set by the Council in 1951.1/, the Counctl may wish to decide that the election to fill the vacancy should take place during the ninth session of the Generel Assembly, prior to the regular election to be held during the same session to elect five members of the court.
