"I have just learned that the Belgian national group has nominated se as a candidate for re-election as Judge of this Court.

While I deeply appreciate the honour thus conferred on me by the Enlylan national group, I regret that it is necessary to inform you that I shall not be a randidate for re-election.

"I am bringing this matter to your attention, in order to avoid possible confusion and subarraneously when the election takes place."
