France, Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland  
and United States of America: joint draft resolution

The Security Council,

Recalling that in Article 2 of the Charter all members are obligated  
to settle their disputes by peaceful means and to refrain from the threat or use  
of force in a manner inconsistent with the purposes of the United Nations,

Deploing the use of force by India in Goa, Damao and Diu,

Recalling that Article 1 (2) of the Charter specifies as one of the purposes  
of the United Nations to develop friendly relations among nations based on respect  
for the principle of equal rights and self-determination of peoples,

1. Calls for an immediate cessation of hostilities;
2. Calls upon the Government of India to withdraw its forces immediately  
to positions prevailing before 17 December 1961;
3. Urges the parties to work out a permanent solution of their differences  
by peaceful means in accordance with the principles embodied in the Charter;
4. Requests the Secretary-General to provide such assistance as may be  
appropriate.
