DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE EGYPTIAN QUESTION SUBMITTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE
OF BRAZIL AT THE ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINTH MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The Security Council,

Having considered the dispute between the United Kingdom and Egypt,
brought to its attention by the letter of the Prime Minister of Egypt
dated 8 July 1947,

Noting that the methods of adjustment provided for by Article 33 of
the Charter have not been exhausted, and believing that the settlement of
the dispute may best be attained, under present circumstances, through
recourse to those methods;

RECOMMENDS to the Governments of the United Kingdom and Egypt:

- (a) to resume direct negotiations and, should such negotiations fail,
to seek a solution of the dispute by other peaceful means of their
own choice;
- (b) to keep the Security Council informed of the progress of these
negotiations.
