DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE INDONESIAN QUESTION SUBMITTED
BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF AUSTRALIA AT THE ONE HUNDRED AND
NINETY-SECOND MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Security Council on 1 August 1947, called upon the Netherlands and the Republic of Indonesia to settle their disputes by arbitration or by other peaceful means, and keep the Security Council informed about the progress of the settlement,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that negotiations should commence as soon as possible with a view to a just and lasting settlement
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

requests the Governments of the Netherlands and of the Republic of Indonesia to submit all matters in dispute between them to arbitration by a commission consisting of one arbitrator selected by the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, one by the Government of the Netherlands, and one by the Security Council.
