**DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE INDONESIAN QUESTION
SUBMITTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM
AT THE ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY-THIRD
MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL**

THE SECURITY COUNCIL,

Having been seized by the Governments of Australia and India of the situation in Indonesia;

Considering that the Government of the Netherlands in invoking Article II, paragraph 7 of the Charter, contests the competence of the Security Council to deal with the question of which it has thus been seized;

Considering the debates which have taken place on this subject in the Security Council;

Requests the International Court of Justice, under Article 96 of the Charter, to give it, as soon as possible an advisory opinion on whether the Security Council is competent to deal with the aforementioned question;

The Secretary-General is instructed to place the documentation submitted to the Security Council regarding the question and the records of the meetings devoted to it at the disposal of the International Court of Justice.
