LETTER DATED 30 AUGUST 1963 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE CONGO (BRAZZAVILLE)
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to inform you, on behalf of the Delegations of
Algeria - Burundi - Cameroun - Central African Republic - Congo-Brazzaville -
Congo-Leopoldville - Ivory Coast - Dahomey - Ethiopia - Gabon - Upper Volta -
Liberia - Libya - Madagascar - Mali - Mauritania - Niger - Nigeria - Uganda -
Rwanda - Senegal - Sierra-Leone - Somalia - Sudan - Tanganyika - Chad -
Togo - Tunisia

that their representatives decided unanimously on 27 August 1963 to give their
complete support to the terms of the letter S/5382 of 2 August 1963 which was
addressed to you by the Representatives of Ghana, Guinea, Morocco and the United
Arab Republic concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia. Accordingly, they
also support that letter's request for a meeting of the Security Council to
consider that question.
