LETTER DATED 12 MAY 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions of my Government I have the honour to request you to convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the acts of armed attack, shelling, incursion, murder and violence perpetrated from Lebanese territory against the territory and population of Israel in flagrant violation of the cease-fire and the United Nations Charter. Particulars of these acts of aggression are contained in my letters to the President of the Security Council of 5 January 1970 (8/9593), 15 January 1970 (8/9604), 29 January 1970 (8/9621), 27 February 1970 (8/9670). 4 March 1970 (8/9678), 10 March 1970 (8/9691), and 10 May 1970 (8/9790).
