

## Report of Honduras on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004)

The Government of Honduras, in relation to Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) and as a State party to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, confirms that it does not possess nuclear facilities or weapons and did not participate in the development, production, testing, deployment or storage of nuclear equipment in 2018, and therefore submits a "nil" report on nuclear disarmament.
