**Follow-up report of the Republic of Korea on the  
implementation of resolution 1718 (2006)**

As a measure to fulfil the obligation to prevent the export of luxury goods to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, pursuant to operative paragraph 8 (a) (iii) of resolution 1718 (2006), the Government of the Republic of Korea is in the process of drafting a list of items it considers to be luxury goods, including luxury motor vehicles, high-end electronic devices, luxury food and alcoholic beverages, luxury recreational items, luxury furniture, precious stones, luxury accessories and designer apparel. After the completion of the list, the Government of the Republic of Korea will inform the Security Council of the list of luxury goods and the administrative measures to implement the ban on luxury goods.
