### **Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)**

#### **Note verbale dated 20 April 2010 from the Permanent Mission of Bulgaria to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations, in reference to the letter dated 18 February 2010 from the Chair of the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), has the honour to communicate that Security Council resolution 1718 (2006) has been implemented through Decree No. 91 of 9 April 2001 on the approval of a list of countries and organizations with regard to which Bulgaria, in accordance with resolutions of the Security Council and with decisions of the European Union and the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe, applies prohibition or restrictions on the sale and supply of arms and related materiel. Through the adoption of Decree No. 3 of 15 January 2007, the measures envisaged in Council resolution 1718 (2006) have been directly incorporated in paragraph 11 of Decree No. 91 and their observation is obligatory.

Security Council resolution 1874 (2009) is directly implemented in the national legislation of Bulgaria, and of all members of the European Union, through the adoption of Council regulation No. 1283/2009 of 22 December 2009. The Council regulation reflects the measures envisaged in both Security Council resolution 1718 (2006) and resolution 1874 (2009) and provides for additional measures to be taken by the members of the European Union.
