Report of the Principality of Andorra on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1985 (2011)

The Principality of Andorra, a country with a long tradition of peace, has always expressed its support for the defence and promotion of international peace and security.

An advocate of peace, the country has lived without war or conflict for more than seven centuries. Andorra has never allowed any activity that could endanger the stability of the region to take place in its territory.

By its resolution 1985 (2011), paragraph 4, the Security Council urges all States, relevant United Nations bodies, and other interested parties to cooperate fully with the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and with the Panel of Experts, in particular by supplying any information at their disposal on the implementation of the measures imposed by resolution 1718 (2006) and resolution 1874 (2009).

On 6 August 2009, the Permanent Mission of the Principality of Andorra sent a note verbale to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) with information on the measures taken to implement Security Council resolution 1874 (2009).

The Principality of Andorra has no further information on the implementation of the measures imposed by resolution 1718 (2006) and resolution 1874 (2009).
