

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 1 April 2014 from the Permanent Mission of the Philippines to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Philippines to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and has the honour to convey the action taken by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines with reference to relevant Security Council resolutions concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea:

- (a) The National Intelligence Coordinating Agency has updated its database on the list of entities, individuals and goods subject to the measures imposed by the Security Council under paragraph 9 of its resolution 1718 (2006), as modified by its resolution 1874 (2009);
- (b) The Bureau of Immigration has already placed on its blacklist the names of the individuals contained in annex I to Security Council resolution 2094 (2013);
- (c) The Bureau of Customs has issued a memorandum directing all Deputy Commissioners, Service Directors, District Collectors and Heads of Customs X-Ray Inspection Projects to be on guard and/or to monitor and possibly blacklist entities and individuals, based on suspicion of their corresponding shipments, to prevent their entry or transit through the Philippines;
- (d) The Philippine National Police has directed its concerned units to intensify intelligence monitoring of the activities of those entities and individuals affiliated with the Democratic People's Republic of Korea who are subject to asset freeze and travel ban which are included in the Security Council consolidated list.
