Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 15 April 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations has the honour to address the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea in reference to the implementation of the sanctions measures adopted by the Committee.

In this regard, the Mission is pleased to report that, since the establishment of the Committee, Uruguay has implemented the sanctions by notifying the competent public authorities, including the Ministry of Defence, the Ministry of Interior, the National Customs Directorate, the Central Bank of Uruguay and the National Anti-Money-Laundering Unit, of such measures. These entities have reported that no cases have been identified to date. It should be noted that, in general, the measures adopted by the Committee are directly applicable and, to date, have not required approval by the national legal system.
